

SAP STRIP

A timber cleaner for removing tannins and extractives for new and all unpainted timber.

Product Advantages

- Remove tannins and extractives.
- Remove mill glaze to allow penetration of the coating.
- Don't have to wait for the timber to weather before applying coatings.

Typical Applications

All timbers under 12 months old where full weathering hasn't yet occurred.

Coverage: 300g container will clean approximately 25-30 m² of decking and 50 m² of vertical surfaces.

Application Methods:

- Decking
 - Dissolve 300g in 5 litres of hot water.
 - Apply with a brush or garden spray.
 - Agitate with a stiff broom or brush to bring to the surface tannins and extractives.
 - Leave on for 15-30 minutes.
 - Wash off with a strong jet of water (preferably a power wash) to rid the surface of any residual cleaner and tannins brought to the surface.
- Vertical surfaces
 - Dissolve 300g in 10 litres of hot water.
 - Apply as above.

Note: Mill glaze is a term used when the planers or blades in the dressing process close the top cells of the timber, this gives the timber a polished appearance. If this surface isn't broken the coating will not be able to penetrate the timber causing early adhesion failure.

Clean Up: Clean all equipment using water.
